



MentorNet has only been available at the Hiland Facility; but is temporarily shut down due to recent COVID cases. Once COVID subsides it should restart. Thanks to all the ladies who have faithfully participated with Chaplain Eileen in this great program. The ladies of the TLC Program have greatly benefited due to your love, care and sacrifice. To date we've not been able to initiate MentorNet for either ACC nor PCC due to restrictions and delays. We are praying once COVID subsides the doors will open and we can begin the MentorNet program in these institutions.
